New Design, “SCALLOPED IMPLANT!”

Lifelike esthetics comes naturally and effortlessly to NobelPerfect. The revolutionary scalloped profile is designed to support the interproximal bone ridge and make natural soft tissue contours possible with implants. The result is optimal esthetics with patient-pleasing beautiful papillae.

A scalloped application of TiUnite surface defines the bone heights. The 1.5mm-wide uncoated titanium band encourages soft tissue attachment and along with the underlying bone supports the papillae.

“NobelPerfect” partially edentulous patients have high esthetic demands. Today’s understanding of the biologic width around an implant provides the scientific basis for a new implant design to fulfill these requirements.



The overall goal is to maintain or create harmony and continuity of the soft tissue. To obtain long term predictable esthetics success, predictable underlying osseous structures must be present. The scalloped implant was designed to

provide a reference point for remodeling according to these principles.

Initial clinical results indicate that bone loss adjacent to the scalloped implant was significantly reduced or eliminated. This is an exciting time in the evolution of implant dentistry.
